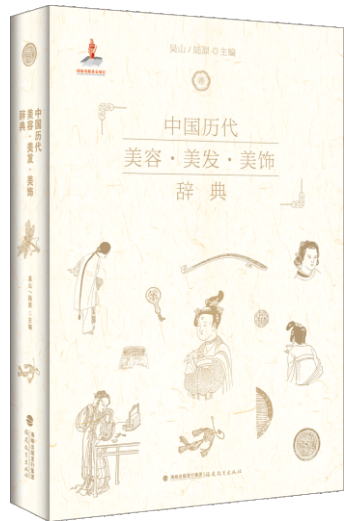


Culture of Vehicles in Ancient China

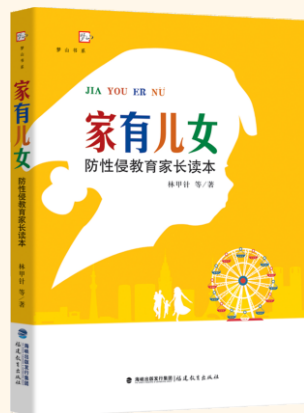

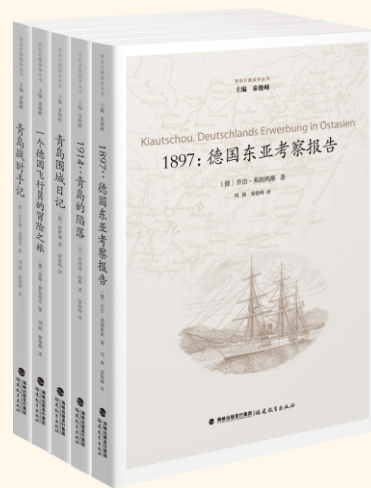

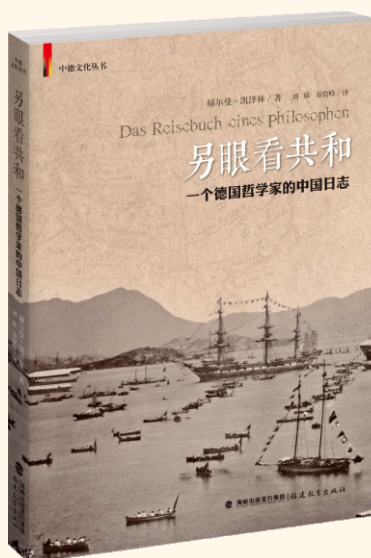
Records of Qingdao in Wartime
